Competition Cancellation Policy

The Executive Moot Court strives to build and maintain a professional relationship with the many lawyers and judges we solicit to participate as judges for each competition. These professionals volunteer their time and knowledge to assist both the Moot Court Program and the students who compete. It is vital to the standing of the Moot Court program in the local legal community that the time given be used as efficiently as possible. A participant failing to compete wastes the time so generously given by these professionals and looks bad not only on the part of the student but also on the program.

Therefore, each competition has its own deadline for signing up. You may cancel your participation as a competitor with no adverse effects at any time before the sign-up deadline for that competition. If you cancel your participation

AFTER the sign-up deadline for the competition has passed, you will be banned from participating in any Moot Court competitions for one calendar year.
